 - ◆ All applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 2.8. All must participate in an interview. Applicants will be rated on their involvement in extra-curricular activities, scholastic achievement, financial need, essay submission and interview.

 - Applications must be postmarked by March 26, 2010 and sent to:
